

**Resolution Regarding Approval of Proposed Chancellor's Regulation B-801,
School-Based Budgeting**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Education Law § 2590-g the Panel for Educational Policy has the power and duty to approve all regulations proposed by the Chancellor and any amendments made thereto; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g(8), the Panel for Educational Policy undertook a public review process for review and comment on the proposed Chancellor's Regulation B-801, School-Based Budgeting; and

WHEREAS, such review process included notice of the proposed Chancellor's Regulation via the Department of Education's internet website and circulation of the notice of proposed regulation to all community superintendents, community district education councils, community boards, and school based management teams; and

WHEREAS, such notice further included: a) a description of the purpose and substance of the proposed Chancellor's Regulation; b) information regarding where the full text of the proposed regulation could be obtained; (c) the name, office, address, email and telephone number of the Department of Education representative from whom information concerning the proposed regulation could be obtained; d) the date, time and place of the meeting of the Panel at which the Panel will vote on the proposed regulation; and e) information on how to submit written or oral comments regarding the proposed regulation; and

WHEREAS, such notice and public review process commenced on December 11, 2009, more than forty-five days in advance of the April 20, 2010 meeting of the Panel at which the proposed regulation came before the Panel for a vote; and

WHEREAS, following the public review and comment period, the Panel made available to the public, including via the Department of Education's internet web site, an assessment of all public comments concerning the proposed regulation; and

WHEREAS, the assessment of public comments included a summary and analysis of the issues raised and any significant suggested alternatives; a statement of the reasons why any significant alternatives were not incorporated into the proposed regulation; a description of any changes to the proposed regulation as a result of the public comments; and information regarding where the full text of any approved regulation may be obtained; and

WHEREAS, the Chancellor recommends that the Panel for Educational Policy approve the proposed Chancellor's Regulation B-801; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Panel for Educational Policy to approve the proposed regulation; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law § 2590-g, the Panel for Educational Policy hereby approves the proposed Chancellor's Regulation B-801, School-Based Budgeting.
