

Behavior Policy

All students are expected to treat everyone with respect and consideration. Student behavior that is unsafe, disruptive or disrespectful to fellow students or teachers will not be tolerated. It is essential that all parents support this policy by reinforcing acceptable behavior at home.

Discipline - Code of Behavior

1. We will show respect for ourselves, our fellow students and all adults.
2. We will walk, not run in the halls, basement, schoolyard and stairways.
3. We will always try to talk over our differences with our fellow students.
4. We will obey all rules and regulations in order to be sure that everyone is safe.
5. We will complete our homework daily and come to school with the books and supplies needed for school.
6. We will respect all personal and school property.
7. We will keep our school clean. We will not litter in the classrooms, schoolyard, auditorium or lunchroom.
8. We will come to school on time and in accordance with the dress code policy.
9. We will stop and listen whenever we are signaled to do so.
10. We will be good citizens of our class, our school and our community.

In addition to these guidelines, each class will establish individual classroom expectations, rules and consequences at the beginning of the school year.
