


The student progress grade is based on the *change in student scores* on state tests in English Language Arts and Math between 2012 and 2013, compared to other students in the City who started at the same level.



What percentage of students moved to a less restrictive environment?




The Movement to a Less Restrictive Environment within D75 metric looks at the percentage of students who were integrated into a less restrictive environment within the same District 75 school or a different District 75 school. The percentage of students that were integrated into a less restrictive environment at P.S. Q224 was 6.6%. Compared to other schools in the city serving students with similar characteristics, P.S. Q224's percentage of students that moved to a less restrictive environment was similar.

Students from P.S. Q224 improved less than other students from schools that serve similar populations who received similar scores the prior year.


Mathematics
