Password Protection:

- E-IEP Plus is now password protected. The program opens with "iep" for teachers. Teachers can create individual passwords. Administrators can create a password that will provide access to any IEP on any computer. Email us for that "administrator" password.



IEP Additions/Changes:

- New IEP pages 1, 6 and 9 containing recent New Continuum changes
- Additional pages 3.1, 4.1 and 5.1 to provide additional space to write detailed present level of performances and management needs
- Additional page 6 goals providing space for 4 more Annual Goals bringing the total number of possible goals to 16
- New Due Process Menu containing updated Procedural Safeguard Notices, the NYC Addendum to this notice and the Addendum to Parents Guide to Special Education Services in the New Continuum
- New ZOOM button feature making it possible to enlarge the page to 400% to accommodate visual impairments
- IEP Checklist to help complete IEP's page by page.
- Classroom Modification checklists to help determine management needs
- New quick Sort buttons on the Student Management Lists to sort by last name, official class or school/site in addition to the customized sort button
