**Small Learning Community Schools (SLC):** In the Directory of the NYC Public Schools 2011-2012; SLC schools are described as a large high school focused on creating a personalized learning environment for all students. Small Learning Communities typically range from 250-500 students. There is one principal for the school, with each SLC led by an assistant principal.

**Career and Technical Education High Schools:** In the Directory of the NYC Public Schools 2011-2012; CTE high schools integrate academic study with workforce skills in specific areas.

**Transfer Schools:** On the New York City Department of Education website, transfer schools are explained as small, academically rigorous, full-time high schools designed to re-engage students who are behind in high school or have dropped out. The essential elements of Transfer Schools include: a personalized learning environment, rigorous academic standards, student-centered pedagogy, support to meet instructional and developmental goals, and a focus on connections to college.

**Special Education Services:** Each school page includes the following statement: *This school will provide students with disabilities the supports and services indicated on their IEPs.* High schools offer an array of special education supports and services to students with disabilities so that they can be educated in the most inclusive possible environment. These services include: General education classes with special education services (including Related Services and Special Education Teacher Support Services [SETSS]); Integrated Co-Teaching and Special Class services (For more information on these services please see page ix in the Directory of the NYC Public Schools 2011-2012)

*Note: These supports are **not** provided by District 75 unless described under "District 75 SETSS in the high school".*

**Enrollment:** Information on the number of students attending the high school, and the grades that will be served in the school for the school year 2012-2013 are provided.




