

Blurb: A Day in the Life of a 12:1:4 Student:

Is a daily plan that structures the day into learning and experience blocks in an effort to create a unified approach to instruction for a heterogeneous population of students. By providing a unified instructional plan across the district, there is consistent structure and consistency that enables students and teachers to transfer to any borough's 12:1:4 program in the district and stay within a familiar environment. The basic elements of the day include: A Sensory Period, Instructional Communication Lunch Time Practice, Two Curriculum Blocks (that include full group and small group instructional elements), and Independent Learning/Communication Time and, Parents as Partners shared activity.
