## ***BOR ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 14, FY 2003***

**SUBJECT:** ALLOCATION FOR PSYCHOLOGIST-IN-TRAINING (PIT) PROGRAM

---

The Psychologist-In-Training (PIT) Program offers a one-year salaried internship to eligible bilingual graduate students of school psychology. The primary purpose of the program is to provide interns with field-based experience in the areas of assessment, counseling, consultation and intervention. The PIT program operates from September through June. September is reserved for professional development activities conducted by the Division of Human Resources (DHR). In the remaining months (October through June), interns work in schools with a certified school psychologist. In exchange, interns agree to work in the City School System for a minimum of two years.

Funds to defray the salary cost for PIT interns are now being allocated. Districts receive eleven months' cost -- October through August -- while DHR receives September's cost. Allocations listed on the attached table are based on participation data provided by DHR.

Allocations for the Division of Human Resources are in District 46's base budget. Its liaison in the Budget Office should be contacted for budgeting information. Community school district allocations will be placed in quick-object-line codes: 004577-053-5141. Districts should prepare budget modifications scheduling the lump sum on the appropriate line in the School Based Support Team (SBST) quick code. The Division of Human Resources will transfer the PIT interns onto district's payrolls retroactive to their October 1<sup>st</sup> start date in the district.
