The Operating Standards Aid is distributed in proportion to the audited October 31, 2003 register adjusted to exclude prekindergarten children, pupils over 21, and long term absentees. This categorical allocation is to be used pursuant to Education Law Section 3602 (38) for services and expenses in helping students improve achievement in order to meet the high learning standards and assessments established by the Board of Regents.

Allowable activities include:

- < the provision of direct instructional services to students, including academic intervention services,
- < the provision of appropriate professional development services to teachers, and
- < the developing and sharing of innovative educational practices.
