SUBJECT **EIGHT PLUS PROGRAM ALLOCATION**

The Eight Plus initiative focuses on previously held back eighth grade students who have yet to attain promotional requirements. As per the Deputy Chancellor of Instruction's July 27, 2004 memorandum entitled, "Eight Plus Program", each instructional region will develop a plan to address the needs of these students.

Eight Plus program allocations have been made to the Region Operation Center (ROC) locations via the Galaxy Transfer Utility System. The allocations are displayed below. The ROC will need to consult with the Instructional Leadership Division Superintendent to schedule this allocation.
