

## W. SMALL LEARNING COMMUNITIES

Restructuring large middle schools into small learning communities is a major component of the Chancellor’s educational reform. The program goal is to improve student academic performance through the establishment of a smaller secure nurturing environment. Student populations will be grouped into several small learning communities at the middle school. Each community will have a dedicated teaching staff. Pupils remain in their community with the same teaching staff for the duration of their stay at the middle school.
