SUBJECT: EVENING HIGH SCHOOL

Starting this year, high school superintendents will operate their own evening high school programs. These programs enable day students to make up courses and accumulate credits. Program, site and registration information was disseminated to the field by the Senior Superintendent for High Schools in a September 4, 2001 memorandum entitled, Registration for Evening High Schools, Fall Term 2001.

Tax Levy resources are being allocated in support of this venture. The allocation methodology prorates the funds available according to the prior year's evening school enrollment.

District allocations will be placed in quick code 000800. A budget modification scheduling the allocation in the tax levy budget should be prepared as soon as possible.
