SUBJECT: EMERGENCY IMMIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAM (EIEP)

The distribution of Federal Emergency Immigrant Education Program (EIEP) funds are provided in this memorandum. Normally, the grant flows directly from the State Education Department to the districts. However, since the grant is based on prior year data, as was the case last year, adjustments are required to align school data with current year district/school organizations. Changes include schools in the Chancellor's District along with the respective geographic district, High Schools, and returning Charter schools. The EIEP allocation is summarized on Table 1. Districts are advised to review Tables 2 and 3 for a listing of the public and non-public schools, respectively, whose eligible pupils generated the district's allotment.

The key elements of the Emergency Immigrant Education Program are described in the November 21, 2001 memorandum from the Office of English Language Learners, entitled, "Use of Emergency Immigrant Education Program (EIEP) Funds." For the reader's convenience, the memo is attached. The memo lists two areas of priority:

- Implementation of the Chancellor's recommendations regarding the education of ELLs, and
- Services to students from English-speaking Caribbean countries.

EIEP allocations listed on Table 1 will be placed in district reimbursable budgets on funding line 6918. A budget modification scheduling the funds to grant number 24801 should be prepared as soon as possible. The budget and program narrative should be consistent with the activities described in the District Comprehensive Education Plan (DCEP).

**SUBJECT: USE OF EMERGENCY IMMIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAM (EIEP)
FUNDS**

This memorandum is intended to provide you with guidance on planning for the use of EIEP funds for the following two priority areas:

- **Implementation of the Chancellor's Recommendations regarding the education of ELLs**
- **Services to students from English-speaking Caribbean countries**

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE EDUCATION OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

EIEP funds may be used in part to help support the implementation of selected Chancellor's recommendations regarding the education of ELLs to the extent that such funds are used for services for, and/or otherwise related to, the education of immigrant ELLs eligible for the EIEP. Therefore, it is expected that the use of EIEP funds will be in addition to other available funding sources including, for example, Tax Levy, Part 154 per capita, Title 1/PCEN etc.

EIEP funds have become available in November. They may be used to support the following Chancellor's Recommendations:

Recommendation #1: CLEARLY INFORM PARENTS OF THEIR RIGHT TO CHOOSE AMONG AVAILABLE PROGRAMS

- Conducting the mandated orientations for parents/guardians of newly enrolled immigrant ELLs, including providing them with adequate information to make informed decisions and choices regarding placement of their children in one of the available bilingual and ESL programs/models; providing parent involvement and education activities.

Associated costs include per session hours to conduct orientations/training, translations/interpretations and materials for parents.

Recommendation #3: CREATE A CITYWIDE INTENSIVE ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS ENTERING THE SCHOOL SYSTEM WITH SIGNIFICANT LANGUAGE NEEDS INCLUDING THOSE ENTERING AT GRADE 6 OR LATER

- Piloting the Accelerated Academic English Language Model (AAELM) for newly enrolled ELLs in grade 4-9 to the extent that such AAELM classes include EIEP eligible students. This is a self-contained class model of the Freestanding ESL Program.

Associated costs consistent with this model include supplementary after-school, Saturday and/or summer instructional programs, ESL technology, instructional materials (purchased and/or developed), and related professional development activities.

- Establishing self-contained bilingual and/or ESL literacy classes for immigrant ELL “Students with Interrupted Formal Education” (SIFE). These are reduced size classes of 15 students intended to address the particular instructional needs of ELLs with interrupted or little/no prior formal schooling in their native country.

Associated costs include reduced class size, supplementary after-school, Saturday and/or summer instructional programs, instructional materials (purchased and/or developed), bilingual guidance-related services, parent involvement/education and related professional development activities.

Recommendation #7: IMPROVE TEACHER QUALITY

- Ensure that general education monolingual teachers receive the currently mandated training in ESL methodologies/approaches.

Associated costs include teacher per session hours and/or trainee stipend and related training materials.

STRATEGIES ON THE EDUCATION OF STUDENTS FROM ENGLISH-SPEAKING CARIBBEAN COUNTRIES

As per James A. Kadamus, Deputy Commissioner of Education, State Education Department, June 25, 2001 memo to Members of the Board of Regents (See attachment):

“Students from English-speaking Caribbean countries will be provided with an instructional program that builds upon valuing their language versatility and respect for their cultural background. On the basis of an evaluation of student needs, local districts will identify the most effective manner for addressing the educational needs of these students in a manner consistent with the new standards and assessments. The students will receive full access to educational programs and services that will be provided to students from the English-speaking Caribbean countries in the District Comprehensive Education Plan (DCEP).”

The State’s educational strategy includes the following four components:

1. Identification and Assessment
2. Instructional Program Strategies
 - a) Transitional Newcomer Classes
 - b) Extended Day
3. Professional Development
4. Parent Education

In addition, SED summarizes a “multi-prong funding approach” to support the instructional strategies, including for the short-term, the use of EIEP and Title 1 funds. Districts/schools are encouraged to carefully plan for EIEP programs/services for this particular group of EIEP eligible students consistent with those strategies summarized in the attached progress report.
