SUBJECT: CSE ALLOCATION ADJUSTMENT: \$201,000

In August 2001, the BASIS High School Superintendency, District 76, appealed BOR Allocation Memorandum No. 2, requesting additional funds for CSE evaluations. Based on review of district data and the recommendations of the Chief Executive, Office of School Programs and Support Services, the District 76 per session entitlement will be increased to \$287,000 and the Non-BOE assessments to \$75,000. Compared to the BOR #2 allocation, this action results in an allocation increase of \$201,000. A summary of the allocation adjustment is shown in the table below. Henceforth, these entitlements will be included in future CSE allocations.
