SUBJECT: Granting Title I Status to PS-323

School organization JHS-263 closed June 30, 2001. The school building was then reopened September 1st as PS-323. Prior to its closing, JHS-263 was a Title I target assistance school. Although the school was restructured, the neighborhood demographics remain unchanged. As a result, it is reasonable to assume that the poverty rate at the old school would carry to the new organization. Based on this assumption, PS-323 is considered a Title I target assistance school.

Title I funds are allocated to districts based on the prior year's pupil register and free lunch data. As such, in [BOR Allocation Memorandum No. 1](#), District 23 received Title I resources generated by 153 low income pupils at JHS-263. These dollars should be applied to the provision of supplemental services for eligible students at PS-323.
