SUBJECT: Granting Title I Status to New School, PS-228

Community School District 30 opened a new school, PS-228, at the start of the school year. On June 20, 2001, the Central Board of Education adopted a resolution establishing the school's organization. The resolution indicates that the new school will relieve overcrowding at PS-148 and 149. Since both schools have high concentrations of poverty – 78.27% and 80.86%, respectively – it is reasonable to assume that the new school will have a poverty rate in excess of the 68.24% Title I cutoff. As a result, for the current school year, PS-228 will be considered a Title I target assistance school. Title I resources generated by PS-148 and 149 youngsters may follow the students to PS-228 for the provision of supplemental services.
