SUBJECT: **ALLOCATION FOR PSYCHOLOGIST-IN-TRAINING (PIT) PROGRAM**

The Psychologist-In-Training (PIT) Program addresses the bilingual school psychologist shortage license area. The program includes a one-year internship to eligible bilingual graduate students of school psychology. Interns work under the direct supervision of experienced, certified school psychologists. Furthermore, for those interns who are also participating in the Bilingual Scholarship Program, the Board covers the graduate school expenses. In return, these interns agree to work in the City School System as bilingual school psychologists for a minimum of two years.

In September, the Division of Human Resources provided professional development activities for the PIT interns. From October through August, interns receive field-based experiences by working with certified school psychologists in schools. As a result, funds to defray the salary cost for the PIT interns in September are now being allocated to the Division of Human Resources. Districts are entitled to allocations from October through August. If appropriate, step increments have been added. The attached table lists each district's entitlement. The allocation is based on information provided by the Division of Human Resources.

Allocations for the Division of Human Resources are in District 46's base budget. Its liaison in the Budget Office should be contacted for budget information. Community school district allocations will be placed in the lump sum to be scheduled for psychologist-in-training, quick-object-line codes: 004577-053-5141. Districts should prepare budget modifications scheduling the lump sum on the appropriate line in the School Based Support Team (SBST) quick code. The Division of Human Resources will transfer the PIT interns onto district payrolls with an October 1st effective date.
