SUBJECT: HealthSTAT SCHOOL INCENTIVE AWARDS

The Mayor's Office of Health Insurance Access (MOHIA) HealthSTAT Program has granted awards to thirty-three schools that have successfully enrolled students in public health programs. Based on a commitment of funds from the Mayor's Office of Management and Budget, advance allocations are being made to districts (see Table 1).

Awards are granted to schools that enroll between 70 and 100 percent of their uninsured students into Medicaid and Child Health Plus. The grant stipulates that funds must be used for "educational purposes," consistent with BOE spending guidelines.

Allotments will be placed in tax levy budgets, quick-object-line codes 004577-053-5141 for community school districts and 000800-053-5141 for high schools. Districts should prepare budget modifications scheduling their allotment as soon as possible.

This is the third HealthSTAT allocation of the fiscal year. Previous allocations were made on August 16, 2001 and January 14, 2002. The three HealthSTAT allocations total \$914,700. An allocation summary is presented on Table 2.
