**SUBJECT: PARAPROFESSIONAL-TO-TEACHER LEAVE PROGRAM**

The intent of the Paraprofessional-to-Teacher Leave Program is to increase the number of teachers serving in shortage license areas by offering paraprofessionals a paid leave for study of up to one year. The venture allows paraprofessionals to obtain their baccalaureate degrees at an accelerated pace. Full time college tuition is provided through the career Training Program. Funds to cover the paid leave are provided in this memorandum. The program description as well as the application and selection process, may be found in Personnel Memorandum No. 28, 2000-2001, dated March 23, 2001.
