SUBJECT: **AUTONOMY ZONE PER CAPITA ALLOCATION**

In an effort to support the independent instructional plans of the schools in the Autonomy Zone (AZ), start-up funds for curriculum will be provided to those schools choosing not to use the core curriculum. The majority of AZ schools are new schools therefore these funds will help establish a working collection of curriculum materials aligned with the school's autonomous instructional plans.

The allocation methodology is as follows:

New Schools

Per Capita of \$32/student for the grade(s) being phased in this fall using the October 2005 projected registers. This is only for schools in the zone choosing not to use the core curriculum.

Existing Schools

Per Capita of \$10 for middle and high school grades and \$20 for elementary grades using the October 2005 projected registers. This is only for schools in the zone choosing not to use the core curriculum.

Funds should be scheduled in the allocation category **"TL Instructional Programs"** or **"TL Instructional Programs HS"**.
