SUBJECT: **TITLE III RESOURCES FOR SUMMER SCHOOL 2006**

This memorandum presents the Title III resources that will support summer school programs in Summer 2006. Funds are for supplemental services specifically for English Language Learners (ELLs), who are not subject to promotional standards. (ELLs subject to promotional standards participate in the regular tax-levy summer school program. Low level 2 students subject to promotional standards participate in the supplementary Title III program.) **These funds may not be used to provide mandated services.**

Title III requires its funds to support opportunities for language development and academic achievement. Title III funded supplemental programs will be used to support non-mandated newcomers, students with interrupted formal education (SIFE), and, in high schools, credit recovery/acceleration for ELLs.

The Title III funded summer school program is a language development enrichment program that supports direct instructional services through theme-based activities. Professional development activities must support the Title III instructional services. Also, instructional materials purchased with Title III funds must align with both the Title III services provided and the appropriate content area standards. High schools may use Title III funds to offset the excess cost of bilingual and ESL courses that are offered to ELLs for credit recovery/acceleration in their summer programs.

Title III funds may not be used to purchase core (i.e., basic) textbooks, materials, or supplies for mandated services. All Title III materials and services must be directly related to and aligned with the activities funded by Title III. All Title III expenditures must comply with allowable Title III cost factors and follow the Title III plan that is detailed in the budget narratives.

Funds have been placed in the District "S" location codes via the Galaxy Transfer Utility System. Allocations should be scheduled using the allocation category "[Title III Summer](#)." Title III should not be scheduled in the "D96" location code.
