## **SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 44, FY07**

**SUBJECT:** **LEAD TEACHER ALLOCATION**

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The Lead Teacher Program was established as a result of the new collective bargaining agreement. Lead teachers spend half their time teaching classes and half their time serving as professional development resources for their schools. Since the program is intended to target schools with the highest need, applications were made available to SURR schools, impact schools, and schools that are in first or second year of restructuring under NCLB accountability rules.

Lead teacher positions were advertised through a city-wide posting beginning March 23. Each Regional Superintendent appointed a designee to serve on a committee convened by the DOE to review applications and determine final recommendations for Chancellor approval. The selection process was two-fold: first, the regional personnel committee selected a pool of applicants with the best qualifications, according to criteria established by the committee; second, each school selected to participate established its own personnel committee.

In elementary schools, lead teachers work as a pair; two lead teachers have responsibility for one regular class. They share a preparation period, and spend half the day teaching their class and half providing professional support to teaching staff. In middle schools and high schools, lead teachers teach three regular classes per day and provide professional support to teaching staff three periods per day. In addition, lead teachers attend five days of professional development prior to the start of the work year and four hours per month outside of the normal workday, according to a plan set and approved by the applicable Regional Superintendent. Lead teachers receive a bonus of \$10,000. Aside from this supplemental salary, the lead teachers will not receive additional compensation for the five workdays and the four hours per month.

Each school that applied and was approved for this subsidized program will have two lead teachers. This allocation provides funds for one lead teacher at the school's average teacher salary plus a \$10,000 bonus, while the school is responsible for the salary and \$10,000 bonus for the other lead teacher. The funds for this allotment were placed the category "[TL Lead Teacher](#)."
