Title I Part A and D funds are being provided to districts responsible for delivering supplemental instructional services to neglected and delinquent children.

Institutions for neglected children are covered under Part A of the Title I law. As such, it follows the County Provision and utilizes the borough per capita developed in School Allocation Memorandum No.3. Institutes for delinquent children are covered under Part D of the Title I law. This part appropriates specific amounts for delinquent children. Details of the two allocations are presented in Tables 1 and 2 respective.

Title I Delinquent and Neglected allocations will be placed in the ROC locations via the Galaxy Transfer Utility. The allocation categories are **"TITLE I N AND D D79"** and **"TITLE I N AND D CW"**.
