SUBJECT: **New School Implementation Allocation**

In FY06, the Office of New Schools provided planning allotments to new schools scheduled to open September, 2006. These schools received 50% of a \$20,000 planning grant. The funds were intended to support the cost of per session activities, professional development, consultants, recruitment and other implementation expenses. The remaining 50% is now being provided in this memorandum. The table below displays each school's FY07 allocation.
