SUBJECT: **Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (JROTC) Supplemental Funding**

This memorandum provides tax levy support to help defray costs associated with the JROTC program currently located in nineteen (19) high schools throughout the city. The tax levy funding should be used to offset salary costs for forty-five ROTC instructors not covered through the Armed Forces ROTC reimbursable grant. The allocation is presented on the attached table.

Schools that have not received their ROTC grants will be provided with tax levy funding to cover full salary costs. Once the Armed Forces funding is received, the tax levy allocation will be adjusted accordingly. Any schools signing a contract for a JROTC program will be expected to self-fund the program. Any increase in instructors in current programs will also be self-funded by the school. No additional allocations will be provided.

Any questions related to this program should be directed to the Senior Grants Officer of each Region.
