

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 11, FY08

SCHOOL SUCCESS GRANT

Summary

The School Success Grant (SSG) will provide supplementary funding to low-performing schools. The SSG consolidates several existing funding streams targeting these schools to improve coherence and accountability for results.

Purpose

In previous years, the DOE has allocated supplementary funding for school improvement through several funding streams: funds to support the improvement efforts of Schools Under Registration Review (SURR) schools, targeted interventions in Schools in Need of Improvement (SINI) schools, middle school and ninth grade intervention programs, and small learning communities (SLCs) in middle and high schools. This compartmentalized approach has hindered schools' ability to plan comprehensively, to improve continuously, and to lift student achievement.

The SSG program will target schools deemed low-achieving under the DOE's new accountability system: that is, schools receiving Ds or Fs (unless the school is designated to close), or Cs in three consecutive years; as well as schools identified by the New York State Education Department as Schools Under Registration Review (SURR) (including schools recently removed from SURR status).

Restrictions on Funds

Specifically, these funds may be used to:

- support direct services to students
- support professional development activities (including consultant fees, per session, per diem, conferences)
- purchase supplemental instructional materials, books, and supplies
- create strategies to increase parental and student involvement.

Schools must refer to their approved Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP) and consult with their Community Superintendent (CS) or High School Superintendent (HSS), Senior Achievement Facilitator, and School Support Organization (SSO) for guidance in determining the most appropriate use of these funds to support improvement efforts.

Allocation Formula

Allotments are distributed based on a pupil per capita using October 31, 2006 audited registers (projected registers used in the case of phase-out schools). See the attached document for more details on how allocations were based on a per capita differential approach:

School Success Grants will continue for three years from the initial award.

Technical Information

Schools are required to keep accurate records to continue grant eligibility as follows:

- 2007-2008 School Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP) Continuation/Update
- Purchase orders and other documents related to OTPS expenditures
- In Title I Targeted Assistance and PCEN schools, lists of at-risk students receiving direct instructional services
- Sign-in sheets and agendas for staff development and/or parent involvement activities

SUBJECT: **SCHOOL SUCCESS GRANT**

The School Success Grant (SSG) will provide supplementary funding to low-performing schools. The SSG consolidates several existing funding streams targeting these schools.

In previous years, the DOE has allocated supplementary funding for school improvement through several funding streams: funds to support the improvement efforts of Schools Under Registration Review (SURR) schools, targeted interventions in Schools in Need of Improvement (SINI) schools, middle school and ninth grade intervention programs, and small learning communities (SLCs) in middle and high schools. This compartmentalized approach has hindered schools' ability to plan comprehensively, to improve continuously, and to lift student achievement.

To improve coherence and accountability for results, the School Success Grant (SSG) will consolidate current DOE school improvement funding streams. The SSG program will target schools deemed low-achieving under the DOE's new accountability system. Schools receiving Ds or Fs (unless the school is designated to close), or Cs in three consecutive years; as well as schools identified by the New York State Education Department as Schools Under Registration Review (SURR) (including schools recently removed from SURR status) will receive SSG funding.

Title I funds will provide supplementary resources to support school improvement efforts in eligible Title I C/D/F or SURR schools. PCEN funds will provide the comparable support in eligible non-Title I schools. Allocations are presented on the attached table.

Guidelines for School Success Grant (SSG) Allocations

Following the receipt of a grade of D or F or three consecutive Cs on School Progress Reports, and/or identification as a SURR, schools that are not identified for closure will be required to establish one-year improvement targets and adopt satisfactory school improvement plans to be approved by the Office of Accountability, and will be eligible for a School Success Grant to support the implementation of approved improvement strategies. These schools must refer to their approved Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP) and consult with their Community Superintendent (CS) or High School Superintendent (HSS), Senior Achievement Facilitator, and School Support Organization (SSO) for guidance in determining the most appropriate use of these funds to support improvement efforts. Specifically, these funds may be used to support direct services to students; professional development activities (including consultant fees, per session, per diem, conferences); the purchase of supplemental instructional materials, books, and supplies; and strategies to increase parental and student involvement. Please see Galaxy for the specific

cost factors for your allocation category. (Cost factors are subject to modification during the school year.)

Allocation Methodology

Allotments are distributed based on a pupil per capita using October 31, 2006 audited registers (projected registers used in the case of phase-out schools). Allocations were based on the following per capita differential approach:

1. Grade level served: \$123 for elementary schools; \$140 for middle and K-8 schools, and \$150 for high schools and secondary schools.
2. Progress Report grades: 100% per capita for all schools that receive a Progress Report grade of D or F (in September 2007) (unless the school is designated to close), or in subsequent years, or a grade of C for three consecutive years.
3. SURR status: 100% per capita for newly-identified SURR (as of March 2007); 100% per capita for current and recently removed former SURR that receive a Progress Report grade of D or F (in September 2007); 80% per capita for current SURR that DID NOT receive a Progress Report grade of D or F (in September 2007); 66% per capita for former SURR that DID NOT receive a Progress Report grade of D or F (in September 2007).
4. Schools that received Targeted Intervention or SLC funding last year (and do not fall into the categories described in 2 or 3 above) will have their funding reduced using the three-year ramp down model (100% in year 1 of funding; 66% in year 2; 33% in year 3; grant phased out after 3 years).
5. Loss limits: A hold harmless rule was applied to ensure that no school previously funded under the allocations consolidated under the new SSG will lose more than \$150k as compared to last year's funding level.

School Success Grants will continue for three years from the initial award.

Funds should be scheduled in the following Allocation Categories:

Schools may schedule funds, but may not expend them until formal approval of school improvement plans and improvement targets have been confirmed by the Office of Accountability. All proposed expenditures are also subject to review by Integrated Service Center representatives to ensure compliance with reimbursable funding requirements.
