

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 18, FY08

TL SPEECH/LANGAUGE INTERVENTION PROGRAM (SLIP)

Summary

This allocation provides resources for the Speech/Language Intervention Program (SLIP) to students demonstrating mild to moderate speech/language impairment affecting learning and development.

Purpose

This program reinforces provision of services in the least restrictive environment to enhance learning.

Restrictions on Funds

Allocations are provided to schools for service to be delivered by Teachers of Speech Improvement during the instructional day.

Allocation Formula

The allocation formula was derived by the number of staff required per SLIP times the allocation of \$70,110.

Technical Information

Funding will be allocated directly to the schools. After July 1st, it will be available via transfer utility.
