

## **SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 23, FY08**

### **TARGETED SUMMER PREKINDERGARTEN**

#### **Summary**

This allocation supports summer school for prekindergarten students.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of the summer prekindergarten program is to foster children's social-emotional development; to promote early literacy development and dispositions with emphasis on expanding oral language communication skills and phonemic awareness; to develop large and fine motor muscles and to provide creative problem solving opportunities in mathematics, science and social studies. The New York City Prekindergarten Performance Standards will be used as the primary resource for the instructional staff.

#### **Restrictions on Funds**

- Children must be 5 years old by December 1, 2007.
- Economically disadvantaged children are given first priority to participate.
- The program must operate a minimum of 12 hours per week for four to eight weeks.
- An additional adult (paraprofessional) must be provided for classes of 16 to 18 pupils.
- The program must include developmentally appropriate curricula, including the use of learning centers.

#### **Allocation Formula**

A total allocation of \$574,464 is being provided for 66 prekindergarten classes. Schools receive \$8,704 per class.

An allocation of \$574,464 is being provided for 66 prekindergarten classes through the FY2007 New York State (NYS) Targeted Summer Prekindergarten program. This amount is funded by State and Local funds. State guidelines for this program are:

- Children must be 5 years of age by December 1, 2007
- Economically disadvantaged children are given first priority to participate;
- The program must operate a minimum of 12 hours per week;
- Classes must operate from four to eight weeks;
- An additional adult (paraprofessional) is provided for classes of 16 to 18 pupils; and
- The program must include developmentally appropriate curricula, including the use of learning centers.
