SPECIALIZED HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSIONS EXAMS

Summary

This allocation provides funds to cover the administration of admission exams for specialized high schools.

Purpose

Specialized high schools such as Bronx High School of Science, Brooklyn Technical High School, Stuyvesant High School, the High School for Math, Science and Engineering at City College, Queens High School for Sciences at York College, Staten Island Technical High School, and High School of American Studies at Lehman College provide an intensive focus on specific subjects for students who are interested in careers in the primary areas of math, science, career technical education and American studies.

Restrictions on Funds

The allocation provides funds to cover per session activities and OTPS costs including teachers, paraprofessionals, school aides, security, guidance counselors, postage and supplies.

SUBJECT: **SPECIALIZED HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSIONS TESTING**

This memorandum describes the resources provided for specialized high school admissions testing. One of the goals of the Children First reform agenda is to ensure that **all** students have the opportunity to succeed in 21st-century workplaces and communities. New York City's specialized high schools (Bronx High School of Science, Brooklyn Technical High School, Stuyvesant High School, the High School for Math, Science and Engineering at City College, Queens High School for Sciences at York College, Staten Island Technical High School, and High School of American Studies at Lehman College) provide an intensive focus on specific subjects for students who are interested in careers in specific areas. The primary emphasis in most of these schools is math and science. Other schools focus on career technical education to provide practical, hands-on learning for students. Another school focuses on the field of American studies.

The allocation provides funds to cover per session activities and OTPS costs including teachers, paraprofessionals, school aides, security, guidance counselors, postage and supplies. The above allotments will be placed in: **TL One Time Allocation HS.**
