

## **SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 37, FY08**

### **BEACON PROGRAM**

#### **Summary**

Beacon programs provide “engaging and appropriately structured activities” during and after the school day. This allocation funds custodial services for school facilities that are used after normal school hours for Beacon Program activities.

#### **Purpose**

The Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) has been administering Beacon Programs since 1991. Beacon programs operate in approximately 80 NYC public schools and provide after-school services for students. The services range from academic support to recreational activities, such as tutoring, college-prep, sports and clubs. The goal is to improve students’ educational achievement and provide the life and social skills they need to be good citizens.

The current allocation provides resources to cover after school custodial costs for extended use of school facilities associated with use of school buildings.

**SUBJECT:** **BEACON PROGRAM**

The Department of Youth and Community Development (DYCD) has been administering Beacon Programs since 1991. Beacon programs operate in approximately 80 NYC public schools. These programs provide “engaging and appropriately structured activities” during and after the school day. The current allocation provides resources to cover after school custodial costs for extended use of school facilities associated with use of school buildings.

Extended use allocations for the Beacon program are being placed in the Integrated Service Centers (ISC) Galaxy location codes (chart below). The attached table displays a list of the participating schools. Extended use funding is provided by DYCD via an intra-city transfer. CBO providers are selected and paid by the Department of Youth and Community Development.

The funding for the Children First Network (CFN) schools is being held in reserve and will be allocated at a later date.
