

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 42, FY08

TITLE I NEGLECTED AND DELINQUENT

Summary

This allocation supports supplemental instruction and supplemental support services for neglected and delinquent youth in qualifying institutions.

Purpose

Supplemental instruction and supplemental support services enable neglected and delinquent youth to meet the same challenging academic standards and achievement standards as other students in the State; prevent the at-risk youth from dropping-out of school; and prepare them for secondary school completion, training, employment, or further education.

Restrictions on Funds

Program plans for use of neglected and delinquent funds must be submitted to the New York State Education Department by August 31, 2007.

Allocation Formula

Neglected Children (PART A) – the allocation is determined by multiplying the borough per capita established in School Allocation Memorandum No. 4 by the eligible number of children in each agency.

Delinquent Children (PART D) – the allocation is determined by multiplying a set per capita of \$1,665.33 by the eligible number of children for each agency.

Title I Part A and D funds are being provided to districts responsible for delivering supplemental instructional services to neglected and delinquent children.

Institutions for neglected children are covered under Part A of the Title I law. As such, it follows the County Provision and utilizes the borough per capita developed in School Allocation Memorandum No.4. Institutes for delinquent children are covered under Part D of the Title I law. This part appropriates specific amounts for delinquent children. Details of the two allocations are presented in Tables 1 and 2 respectively.

Title I Delinquent and Neglected allocations will be placed in the ISC locations via the Galaxy Transfer Utility. The allocation categories are "**TITLE I N AND D D79**" and "**TITLE I N AND D CW**".
