

SUMMARY OF ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 46, FY08

New Schools Implementation Grants

Summary

This allocation provides funds to new schools to support them through the planning process. The funding is intended for schools with limited access to planning resources.

Purpose

Some startup schools have formed partnerships with intermediaries such as the Gates Intermediary organization. They have gained access to funding to help them plan and execute planning processes. The Office of New Schools has stepped in to compensate for resources not accessible to schools that are not in partnerships.

Restrictions on Funds

The funds are intended to help cover the costs of per session activities, professional development, consultants, recruitment and other implementation expenses.

SUBJECT: **New School Implementation Allocation**

In FY08, the Office of New Schools has provided planning allotments to new schools scheduled to open September 2007. Some of the startup schools have formed partnerships with intermediaries through which they have gained access to resources to help implement their planning processes. The grant is intended to support those that do not have alternative resources. The funds are earmarked for offsetting costs of per session activities, professional development, consultants, recruitment and other implementation expenses. The table below displays each school's FY08 allocation.
