

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 47, FY08

READING FIRST — YEAR 5

Summary

This allocation provides coach funding the Reading First program.

Purpose

Reading First is a program started by the federal government as part of the No Child Left Behind law to ensure that every student is reading at grade level by the end of third grade. Through Reading First, states and districts receive funds to put in place reading programs that are based on scientific research and have been proven to work in classrooms. A key element of this program is having reading coaches who provide intensive, specialized instruction to help students catch up.

Restrictions on Funds

Allocation Formula

Reading First coach positions are supported by FY08 Reading First funds. The allotment is based on the following criteria:

- One to two full-time coaches allocated to each school based on the number of students enrolled in the program.
- The cost for school coaches based on an average coach salary of \$75,000 or \$103,620, including fringe benefits.

SUBJECT: **Reading First (Year 5)**

Reading First is a federal funded literacy program which aims to help public and non-public low income students in grades K through 3 learn to read well by the end of third grade. This memo provides resources to participating schools for Reading First coaches assigned to their building. The attached table lists each school's allocation.

The allotment is based on the following criteria:

- One to two full time coaches allocated to each school based on the number of students enrolled in the program.
- The cost for school coaches based on an average coach salary of \$75,000 or \$103,620 including fringe benefits.
