

## **SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 55, FY08**

### **UFT UNION OFFICERS, DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES AND FUNCTIONAL CHAPTER LEADERS**

#### **Summary**

This allocation provides funds to cover instructional services lost when United Federation of Teachers (UFT) union officers, district representatives and functional chapter leaders who are assigned to schools must be absent because they are performing their union functions.

#### **Purpose**

Union representatives need time during the day to perform their union roles, such as investigating member grievances. As part of the agreement between UFT and the Department of Education, UFT union officers and district representatives are excused after teaching one period a day. UFT functional chapter leaders are allowed time per week for activities relating to the duties of their office. Schools that are affected by these absences must hire substitutes so that students do not lose instructional time.

#### **Restrictions on Funds**

#### **Allocation Formula**

The UFT reimburses the Department of Education for three lost instructional periods for union officers and district representatives at the rate of \$33.76 per period covered.

United Federation of Teachers (UFT) Union Officers, District Representatives and Functional Chapter Leaders who are assigned to schools are granted "release time" in order to perform duties on behalf of the UFT. Funds are being provided directly to schools to help defray costs associated with the lost of instructional services stemming from these activities.

UFT Union Officers and UFT District Representatives teach one period a day and are excused after their teaching period. The UFT reimburses the Department of Education for three lost instructional periods at the coverage rate per period of \$33.76. This reimbursement is being allocated back to affected schools.

The UFT Functional Chapter Leaders are allowed time per week for investigation of grievances and for other appropriate activities relating to the administration of the agreement (between DOE and UFT) and the duties of their office. Affected schools will receive funds to offset substitute costs incurred while the functional chapter leader is excused.

The attached table lists each school's allocation by UFT Union Office, UFT District Representative and UFT Chapter Leader. Allotments were placed in the "**TL One-Time Allocations**", "**TL One-Time Allocations HS**" or "**TL Instructional Program CW**" allocation category.
