### **PREDICTIVE/TEACHERS COLLEGE READING AND WRITING PROJECT (TCRWP) PERIODIC ASSESSMENT ALLOCATION**

#### **Summary**

The Predictive/Teachers College Reading and Writing Project (TCRWP) Leveling Guide Package assessment initiative is geared toward assisting schools in developing and using assessment techniques and tools to achieve the educational objectives of the Periodic Assessment Program.

#### **Purpose**

The initiative provides educators with important information to help them with instructional decisions throughout the year, including measuring student achievement and progress according to New York State ELA standards, and reading accuracy, fluency, and comprehension.

#### **Restrictions on Funds**

Funds are targeted to support schools in duplicating and purchasing books and assessment materials to administer TCRWP Leveling Guide Assessments throughout the year; developing approaches to track and share students' information; and designing a school-wide professional development plan around the assessment information.

(TCRWP) PERIODIC ASSESSMENT ALLOCATIONS

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Through the Predictive/TCRWP Leveling Guide Package assessment initiative, the Department of Education is providing funding to schools across School Support Organizations to support assessment activities in English-Language Arts. The initiative is geared to assist schools in developing and using assessment techniques and tools to achieve the educational objectives of the Office of Accountability's Periodic Assessment Program.

### **Predictive/TCRWP Leveling Guide Package**

Based on school feedback, the Office of Accountability has created a new English-Language Arts (ELA) periodic assessment package for grades 3-8 for the 2007-2008 school year. This joint project includes two Predictive Assessments offered by CTB/McGraw-Hill and three Leveling Guide Assessments designed by the Teachers College Reading and Writing Project and thirty Empowerment Schools. This blended approach provides important information that will measure student achievement according to New York State ELA standards, and particularly in reading accuracy, fluency, and comprehension. Together, this set of assessments gives educators data to help them with instructional decisions throughout the school year.

One hundred and twenty-six schools will receive funding for the Predictive/TCRWP Leveling Guide Package during the 2007-2008 school year. All DOE schools, grades 3-8, were eligible to select this package for their ELA periodic assessment plan.

Funds are specifically targeted toward the schools' implementation, interpretation, and communication of assessment materials and results. The allocation is conditioned on schools' complying, whenever applicable, with the requirements set forth in the Office of Accountability's **Periodic Assessment 2 Predictive / 3 TCRWP Leveling Guide Package** description.

The attached table displays the allocation for each school that selected the Predictive/TCRWP Leveling Guide Package initiative. Funds should be scheduled in the allocation category "**TL DYO Assessment.**"
