

## **SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 60, FY08**

### **LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENT (LEP)— TITLE III- REVISED OCTOBER 2, 2007**

#### **Summary**

This allocation provides funds for supplemental services for English Language Learners (ELLs), including teacher professional development and parent involvement initiatives, to reach the goals of the federal NO Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act, Title III initiative.

#### **Purpose**

NCLB requires all students to be proficient in math and English by 2014. Title III of the law specifically addresses instruction for Limited English Proficient (LEP) students. To reach the NCLB goal of academic proficiency, many students who are not proficient in the English language will need additional support to achieve at high levels. Having high-quality teachers and involved parents are two key factors that will help these students achieve proficiency.

#### **Restrictions on Funds**

- This allocation may not be used to provide mandated bilingual and/or English as a Second Language services for ELLs.
- Title III funds may not be used to purchase core (i.e., basic) textbooks, materials or supplies for mandated services.
- Title III supplemental services for ELLs must include direct instruction and high-quality professional development that is ongoing rather than consisting of one-day or short-term workshops and conferences.
- Parent engagement activities and supports must include appropriate translation and interpretation services.
- Professional development activities must be used to support language development, English and native language instruction, high academic achievement in math and other core academic areas, and/or dual language programs.
- Direct supplemental services should be provided for before- and after-school and Saturday programs, reduced class size, and/or push-in services.
- Teachers providing the services must be certified bilingual education/English as a Second Language teachers.

#### **Allocation Formula**

- This allocation includes \$25.6 million for supplemental services.
  - Schools with 0-29 ELLs in FY07 received \$0.
  - Schools with 30-87 ELLs in FY07 received \$15,000.
  - Schools with more than 88 ELLs in FY07 received \$173.03 per student.

This memorandum presents resources to support the ***FY2008 Federal NO Child Left Behind Act, Title III initiative***. The initiative provides \$25.4M for supplemental services and may not be used to provide mandated bilingual and/or ESL services for English Language Learners (ELLs).

The Office of English Language Learners has established the following Title III guidelines:

Title III supplemental services for ELLs must include direct instruction and high quality professional development that is “of sufficient intensity and duration to have a positive and lasting impact on the teachers’ performance in classrooms.” In addition, the inclusion of parent engagement activities is required. Parent engagement activities and supports must ensure appropriate translation and interpretation services to meet community needs. The professional development activities should be well-planned, ongoing events rather than one-day or short-term workshops and conferences. Professional development activities must be used to support language development, English and native language instruction, high academic achievement in math, high academic achievement in core academic areas, and/or dual language programs.

The Title III supplemental instructional services must focus on language development in English and native language, and high academic achievement in math and/or other core academic areas based on student need. These supplemental services should complement basic bilingual and ESL services required under CR Part 154. Direct supplemental services should be provided for: before/after-school and Saturday programs, reduced class-size, and/or push-in services. Supplemental instructional support for dual language programs is also permitted. Teachers providing the services must be certified bilingual education/ESL teachers.

Priority areas for the use of Title III funds are:

- Improving mathematics teaching and learning,
- Improving native language and English teaching and learning,
- Enriching parent engagement activities and securing appropriate translation and interpretation services,
- Developing New Dual Language Programs,
- Developing new programs for high school Students with Interrupted Formal Education (SIFE), and
- Integrating ELLs in secondary school reforms.

Please be advised that schools receiving Title III funds must complete a Title III application that includes a school plan and a budget narrative describing the use of these monies. Title III funds may not be used to purchase core (i.e., basic) textbooks, materials, or supplies for mandated services. All Title III materials and services must be directly related to activities funded by Title III and kept to a minimum. All Title III funds must be accounted for in the budget narratives which must be aligned to the Title III plan.

For more information about development of the Title III school plan and budget narrative, please contact your School/District Improvement Liaison and your SSO Network Team. The submission of an approvable Title III application is necessary to ensure continued Title III funding.

Schools allocations are based on the following:

- Schools with 0-29 ELLs in FY07 received \$0.
- Schools with 30-87 ELLs in FY07 received \$15,000.
- Schools with more than 88 ELLs in FY07 received \$173.03 per student.

Title III allocations should be scheduled in the allocation category, "[Title III LEP](#)". Citywide Title III allocations should be scheduled in the allocation category, "[Title III LEP CW](#)". **Scheduled funds MUST be reviewed and approved by the Senior Grant Officer (SGO) for fiscal compliance with Title III guidelines.**
