

## **SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 63, FY08**

### **PSYCHOLOGISTS IN TRAINING (PIT) ALLOCATION**

#### **Summary**

This allocation supports one-year, salaried internships to recruit bilingual psychologists.

#### **Purpose**

A student's academic success or failure often is influenced by other factors, such as family, social or psychological issues. In-school psychologists support students and help them overcome these challenges so they graduate high school prepared for the real world. If the psychologists are bilingual, it helps them communicate better with and provide support for students whose native language is not English. Through this internship, bilingual psychologists receive professional development and mentoring. After they complete the program, they agree to work in the school system for at least two years.

#### **Restrictions on Funds**

#### **Allocation Formula**

Allotments are based on an average psychologist in training salary of \$40,014, prorated for October to August (11 out of 12 months at \$40,014 = \$36,680).

**SUBJECT:** **Psychologist-In-Training (PIT) Allocation-REVISED**

The Psychologist-In-Training (PIT) program is a recruitment program focusing on bilingual school psychologist. The program offers a one-year salaried internship. In September, the interns attended professional development workshops conducted by the Division of Human Resources (DHR). For the remaining months (October through June), interns receive school-based mentoring from a school psychologist. Upon completion of the program, interns agree to work in the city school system for a minimum of two years. Currently, there are 30 interns in the PIT program.

Allocations are provided to the Integrated Service Centers (ISCs) for sub-allocation to schools via the Transfer Utility System. The attached table lists each ISC's amount by school. Allotments are based on an average PIT salary of \$40,014 and the October to August value (11/12 of \$40,014=\$36,680). Funds should be scheduled in the Allocation category "**TL SBST**". Resources already reside in the Office of Special Education Initiatives budget to cover September expenditures.
