

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 67, FY08

AFTER SCHOOL FUNDING ALLOCATION

Summary

The State Education Department (SED) appropriated funds as a “special legislative project” to provide additional support for after school programs. The primary intention of this project is to support programs originally funded by Round 1, 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant. Districts should use these funds to cover school and Community Based Organization partnerships, teacher-per session for school initiated after school programs, and after school supplies.

Purpose

After school hours are an important component in students’ lives. After school programs provide opportunities to develop a young person’s social, emotional and academic capabilities. Furthermore, after school hours represent a time when many young people are without parental supervision and need to be in safe and supportive environments. These programs will offer a balanced mix of academic and youth development services.

Restrictions on Funds

These funds are for after school programs only. They can be used for teacher per session for after school programs, payments for community based organization programs, and after school supplies.

Allocation Formula

Each allocation was determined using the percentage of Round 1 funding a district received against the DOE’s total Round 1 allocation. This percentage was then applied to the SED total allocation amount of \$2 million.
