

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 73, FY08

Summary

This allocation provides funding to eligible schools that have registered students transferring from “Schools In Need of Improvement” (SINI) under the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) policy.

Purpose

This weight will create greater opportunities for students at struggling schools to enroll at schools with strong track records by encouraging successful schools to serve more transferring students without compromising these schools’ character or success.

Restrictions on Funds

These are tax levy funds and have no restrictions.

Allocation Formula

The weight is \$2,000 per student.

SUBJECT: **FAIR STUDENT FUNDING NCLB TRANSFER WEIGHT**

This allocation provides resources under Fair Student Funding to eligible schools that have registered students transferring from "Schools In Need of Improvement" (SINI) under the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) policy. The attached table details the allocations per location.

Policy

This transfer weight will create greater opportunities for students at struggling schools to enroll at schools with strong track records by encouraging successful schools to serve more transferring students without compromising these schools' character or success.

We provide \$2,000 per child to a successful school that takes a child transferring through the NCLB Public School Choice process. The \$2,000 will be for each year the child is enrolled at the school, for up to two years. Schools will be eligible for the payment regardless of whether they are being held harmless or receiving new funds under Fair Student Funding (FSF).

Students are only eligible for this FSF weight if they transfer through the centralized NCLB Public School Choice process. The money is provided after the October 31st registers close, for each transfer student that is still enrolled.

All eligible receiving schools are expected to accept transfers under NCLB whether they qualify for this initiative or not.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this funding, a school must:

- Be eligible under State and Federal law to enroll transfers under NCLB Public School Choice, which means the school cannot be a Title I "School In Need of Improvement" or in "Corrective Action" or "Restructuring" under NCLB. Schools classified as "Requiring Academic Progress" are eligible.

- All General Education Schools: Schools earning a Progress Report grade of A or B and a Quality Review score of Proficient or better in 2006-07 are eligible for the Fair Student Funding (FSF) Transfer Bonus, discussed “Monetary Rewards” below.¹
- New Schools: New schools that do not receive a grade in the 2006-07 Progress Report may still be eligible to receive this bonus. If a new school is in the top 40% of schools (by school type – elementary, K-8, middle, high school) in the Progress Report “Student Progress” category, and the school has earned a Quality Review score of Proficient or better.
- Respond to seat analysis from the Office of Student Enrollment and consider making additional seats available for NCLB transfers.
- Enroll students transferring through the NCLB Public School Choice process in fall 2007.

The allocations will be placed in the “**TL Fair Student Funding**” and “**TL Fair Student Funding HS**” allocation categories.

¹ Results from the 2006-07 Progress Reports will be used to identify FSF eligible students/schools in the 2008-09 academic year. In order to qualify for the FSF weight during the 2007-08 academic year, a school must have placed among the top 55th percentile of overall scores in the **pilot** Progress Report.
