

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 75, FY08

Summary

The Office of Accountability is rewarding schools for achieving the highest level of performance on their 2006-07 Progress Reports and Quality Reviews. Schools that received an 'A' on their 2006-07 Progress Report and a 'Well-Developed' on their 2006-07 Quality Review are eligible to receive a financial bonus.

Purpose

As part of the Department of Education's Children First Reforms, the Office of Accountability has developed new tools to evaluate schools. The Progress Report evaluates schools in three areas: School Environment, Student Performance, and Student Progress. The Quality Review evaluates how well schools use information and set goals to improve learning for all students. The Department of Education is rewarding schools for achieving the highest level of performance on these evaluations.

Restrictions on Funds

There are no restrictions on funds provided through the School Bonus. Schools that receive them are asked to serve as demonstration sites for other schools and/or to contribute to the Department's new knowledge management system with descriptions of effective programs, policies, or interventions in effect at the school.

Allocation Formula

The value of the bonus varies by school based on student enrollment as determined using the Audited School Registers from 2006-07 (this is the year for which school performance is evaluated). Schools receive slightly more than \$33/student.

This is a one-time allocation.

SUBJECT: SCHOOL BONUSES

As part of the Department of Education's Children First Reforms, the Office of Accountability has developed new tools to evaluate schools. The Progress Report evaluates schools in three areas: School Environment, Student Performance, and Student Progress. The Quality Review evaluates how well schools use information and set goals to improve learning for all students. The Department of Education is rewarding schools for achieving the highest level of performance on these evaluations.

One hundred thirty-five schools are approved to receive financial bonuses based on their outstanding achievement on the 2006-07 Progress Report and Quality Review. All DOE General Education Schools and Schools for Transfer Students receiving both a Progress Report and Quality Review were eligible for the bonus. One hundred thirty-three of these schools received an 'A' on their Progress Report* and a 'Well-Developed' on their Quality Review. The other two schools also received a 'Well-Developed' on their Quality Review, but did not receive a Progress Report grade because they did not yet have a graduating class. However, these two schools scored in the top 10% of all schools in the Progress Section of the Progress Report, which qualified them, as new schools, for the bonus.

The value of the bonus vary by school based on student enrollment as determined using the Audited School Registers from 2006-07 (this is the year for which school performance is evaluated). Schools receive slightly more than \$33/student.

Funds can be used at the discretion of the school. Schools that receive the funds are asked to serve as demonstration sites for other schools and/or to contribute to the Department's new knowledge management system with descriptions of effective programs, policies, or interventions in effect at the school.

The attached table displays the bonus amount for each school that meets the above criteria. Funds will be placed in the [TL One-Time Allocations](#) and [TL One-Time Allocations HS](#) allocation category.
