

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 82, FY08

READING FIRST PER SESSION ALLOCATION

Summary

The following allocation is provided to public schools participating in the Reading First Program to cover per session costs for school year professional development for teachers and coaches. The program, a K-3 literacy initiative is being funded by a Federally sponsored, state-managed grant.

Purpose

Reading First is a program started by the federal government as a part of the No Child Left Behind law to ensure that every student is reading at grade level by the end of third grade. Through Reading First, states and districts receive funds to put in place reading programs that are based on scientific research and have been proven to work in classrooms. With this allocation, schools receive funds to help enhance the quality of reading instruction through specialized professional development provided to teachers.

Restrictions on Funds

Funds should be used only to cover per session costs for teachers and coaches participating in the Reading First program.

Allocation Formula

- **New schools**
 - Teachers (K-3): 6 hours per month
 - Coaches: 12 hours per month

- **Continuing schools**
 - Continuing teachers (K-3): 2 hours per month
 - New teachers (K-3): 4 hours per month
 - Coaches: 8 hours per month

SUBJECT: **READING FIREST PER SESSION ALLOCATION**

The following allocation is provided to public schools participating in the Reading First Program to cover per session costs for school year professional development for teachers and coaches. This program, a K-3 literacy initiative is being funded by a federally sponsored, state-managed grant. Allocations per schools are detailed in the attached table.

Each school is receiving a per session allocation for school year FY08 based on the following categories:

- **Number of K-3 classroom teachers** – the number of educators receiving Professional Development (for Reading First program only) will be based on a list of actual classroom teachers provided by each school.
- **New schools**
 - Teachers: 6 hours per month
 - Coaches: 12 hours per month
- **Continuing schools**
 - Continuing teachers: 2 hours per month
 - New teachers: 4 hours per month
 - Coaches: 8 hours per month

Allotments are placed in the allocation category “**READING FIRST**”.
