

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 88 FY08

FY09 SUMMER SCHOOL PLANNING

Summary

As in 2007, schools will have the authority and associated dollars to develop and implement their own summer school program(s) designed to meet the needs of students who are at risk of not being promoted to the next grade or of not graduating on time. Schools with grades 3-12 are allocated funds to provide resources for summer instructional programs. District 75 and District 79 will continue to be funded through set – asides to support their summer programs

Purpose

Schools, via this allocation memorandum, will receive preliminary figures of their summer instructional allocation to assist them in planning for summer school. Funds will not be allocated to schools until the initial FY 09 budget release scheduled for early May.

Restrictions on Funds

Schools should utilize funds only as a means of planning and implementing a summer school program in FY09.

Allocation Formula

The preliminary allocations were generated for each school using the following academic performance data.

Grades 3-8

Unduplicated level 1 counts based on June 2007 results by school.

Grades 9-12

Well Below Standards Fair Student Funding data. This includes students on the 10/31/07 register that entered the school with one of the following score combinations on ELA and Math tests: 1:1, 0:1, 1:0, 1:2, or 2:1.

The summer 2007 citywide summer school attendance rates were applied to these two datasets. More specifically, a rate of 81% was applied to grades K-8 and 64% to grades 9-12.

Technical Information

In order to account for more up-to-date grade 3-8 test scores in June, the preliminary allocation will only release a portion (75%) of what is generated on the data described above for grade 3-8. The balance will be set aside and allocated based on the results of the 2008 tests results. Allocations will only be adjusted upward and as a result, the per capita in the adjustment period will not equal the per capita at the initial (the set aside will be divided by the total number of new level 1 students each school has). This means schools will not necessarily receive an additional 25%.

This is unlike the 9-12 funding since those results will not change as a result of the updated spring results. The preliminary allocation will be the final allocation.

Please note that the money generated by empowerment schools based on the above methodology was pooled and re-allocated to schools based on 10/31/2007 registers. There will be no adjustment to these funds.

SUBJECT: **FY09 Summer School Planning**

As in 2007, schools will have the authority and associated dollars to develop and implement their own summer school program(s) designed to meet the needs of students who are at risk of not being promoted to the next grade or of not graduating on time. Schools with grades 3-12 are allocated funds to provide resources for summer instructional programs. District 75 and District 79 will continue to be funded through set – asides to support their summer programs.

The spending plan for summer school is listed in table 1 and the preliminary allocations are listed on table 2 for Learning and Partnership Support Organization schools and table 2 for Empowerment Support schools.

The preliminary allocations were generated for each school using the following academic performance data.

Grades 9-12

Well Below Standards Fair Student Funding data. This includes students on the 10/31/07 register that entered the school with one of the following score combinations on ELA and Math tests: 1:1, 0:1, 1:0, 1:2, or 2:1.

Please note that the money generated by empowerment schools based on the above methodology was pooled and re-allocated to schools based on 10/31/2007 registers. There will be no adjustment to these funds.

In addition to the preliminary allocations that cover all aspects of the instructional programs, there are set asides in the summer school budgets that will be released to cover summer school needs. The Integrated Service Centers will work with your programs on these items. The specifics are listed below.
