## SCHOOL ALLOCATION MEMORANDUM NO. 09, FY09

**SUBJECT:** **Summer Instructional Program-Empowerment Support Organizations**

In FY'08, School Allocation Memorandum #88- Summer School Planning provided Empowerment schools a first look at the upcoming summer allocations in order to appropriately plan their summer programs. This memorandum provides resources for the 2008 Summer School program.

As in FY2007, Empowerment Schools will again have the authority and associated dollars to develop and implement their own summer school program(s) designed to meet the needs of students who are at risk of not being promoted to the next grade or of not graduating on time.

The preliminary allocations were generated for each school using the following academic performance data.

Grades 3-8

Unduplicated level 1 counts based on June 2007 results by school.

Grades 9-12

Well Below Standards Fair Student Funding data. This includes students on the 10/31/07 register that entered the school with one of the following score combinations on ELA and Math tests: 1:1, 0:1, 1:0, 1:2, or 2:1.

The summer 2007 citywide summer school attendance rates were applied to these two datasets. More specifically, a rate of 81% was applied to grades K-8 and 64% to grades 9-12.

Please note that the money generated by empowerment schools based on the above methodology was pooled and re-allocated to schools based on 10/31/2007 registers. There will be no adjustment to these funds.

In addition to the preliminary allocations that cover all aspects of the instructional programs, there are set asides in the summer school budgets that will be released to cover summer school needs. The Integrated Service Centers will work with your programs on these items. The specifics are listed below.

- Non-Mandated APs
- IEP Paraprofessionals
- Secretarial Allocation
- Attendance Teachers

- Charter School/Non Public School Students
- Students in Schools Closing in 2008
- Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) Program
- Young Adult Borough Centers (YABCs), Alternative Learning Centers (ALCs)
- District 79 Programs
- District 75 Programs
