**SUBJECT:** **CITY YEAR NEW YORK**

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The City Year program is a public/private partnership between the New York City Department of Education (DOE), Americorps and private entities. The Department of Education funds will primarily support staff and corps members' salaries, both of whom are in the schools most of the time, and comprise no more than 50% of all costs. Costs would include portions of staff salaries, corps members' stipends and benefits; fees for consultants and other non-personnel expenses. The program, which was launched in FY07, will expand to 18 schools in the upcoming school year. Tax levy resources are being provided for this venture.

City Year organizes 17 to 24-year-olds to do a year of full-time service for their community and country. In New York City, City Year specifically focuses on work in high-need public schools. Their goal is to help children learn to read, stay in school and care about their communities. The City Year New York Team promotes academic success through direct tutoring with students, an enhances learning environment through lunch time programming, leads community volunteers in service, and has designed and implemented a service learning program, *AmeriCorps*, during after school hours.

The City Year New York allocation is displayed below. Funds will be automoded into the **TL One-Time Allocations** allocation category under object code 685, program name "City Year".
