SUBJECT: **ATTENDANCE IMPROVEMENT/DROPOUT PREVENTION (AIDP)
DISCRETIONARY ALLOCATIONS**

Attendance Improvement Dropout Prevention (AIDP) Discretionary allocations are being provided to fund attendance support positions in eligible schools. The allocations provide resources for school staff, such as family assistants, guidance counselors and other positions responsible for supporting the attendance program. The total number of schools receiving discretionary funds has increased from 194 last year to 293 this year. Funds that had been allocated to schools that closed as of this year and funds that had been utilized last year for OTPS and per-session activities were re-distributed among AIDP eligible middle and elementary schools. The allocations are displayed on the attached table.

AIDP funding for attendance teacher positions have already been provided through allocations disseminated in School Allocation Memorandum No. 51 "AIDP Attendance Teacher" for this year.

Schools selected to receive funding will be required to record all AIDP funded attendance support and counseling services provided to individual students into the Automate the Schools (ATS) AIDP data base. This data will be monitored to ensure that the schools are providing the indicated AIDP funded services.

School allocations are detailed in Table I and funding for Central Districts and Citywide Special Education will be allocated as detailed in Table II.
