SUBJECT: **FOUNTAS AND PINNELL BENCHMARK ASSESSMENT SYSTEM AND DEVELOPMENTAL READING ASSESSMENT ALLOCATIONS**

As part of the Periodic Assessment Program, this year schools serving students in grades K-2 were allowed to select alternative DOE approved assessment options including the (DRA). These alternatives are geared towards assisting schools in developing and using assessment techniques and tools to achieve the educational objectives of the Office of Accountability's Periodic Assessment Program.

In addition to their chosen assessments, schools may continue to administer ECLAS-2/EPAL. Schools that would like to administer Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessments or DRA in lieu of ECLAS-2/EPAL may do so as long as they are assessing students at least twice per year. Those schools that chose alternate assessments will not receive ECLAS/EPAL materials this year. Instead, they will receive funding to help defray the costs of the alternate assessment programs.

Thirty-six schools will receive funding for the Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessments and thirty-eight schools will receive funding for the Developmental Reading Assessments during the 2008-09 school year. All DOE schools, grades K-2, were eligible to select this package for their Periodic Assessment plan.

Funds are specifically targeted toward the schools' implementation, interpretation, and communication of assessment materials and results. The allocation is conditioned on schools' complying, whenever applicable, with the requirements set forth in the Office of Accountability's ***Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessments*** or ***Developmental Reading Assessments*** descriptions.

The attached table displays the allocation for each school that selected these assessment alternatives. Funds should be scheduled in the allocation category "**TL DYO Assessment.**"
