SUBJECT: **Golden Apple Awards**

The Golden Apple Awards are part of the NYC Department of Sanitation's education and awareness campaign in the schools. The award provides cash prizes to winning schools that conceive and complete exemplary projects demonstrating awareness and civic responsibility in waste prevention, reuse and recycling. To this effort, the Department of Sanitation has awarded \$97,000 to 27 schools for FY09. The attached table details the amounts per school.

Department of Sanitation funding is provided to the DOE via an intra-city transfer. Funds must be expended by June 30, 2009.
