SUBJECT: SAFE SCHOOLS INITIATIVE – TITLE IV ROLLOVER

The NYC Department of Education Office of School and Youth Development (OSYD) will support a cadre of high need schools to achieve improved student behavioral outcomes so that each school provides a safe and supportive environment in which students can achieve academic success. Schools will be identified for support based on the following criteria:

- schools identified as Persistently Dangerous;
- schools designated as Impact schools;
- schools that may be identified as potentially dangerous based on a review of 2007-2008 school incident data;
- schools that are high need based on a review of 2007-2008 school incident data and current 2008-2009 trends

Identified schools will receive services and/or funds for professional development and direct services to students. Professional development is expected to build the capacity of school personnel to sustain long term improved school tone and culture beyond the time frame of this initiative. Direct services to students may be provided by external community-based organization partners or internal school staff for social/emotional learning to build their capacity in conflict resolution skills, anger management, positive relationships with peers and adults, and respect for diversity. Program designs will be developed at the respective schools in partnership with the Office of School and Youth Development.

Allocations are provided on the attached tables. Funds directly allocated to a school's budget will be placed in the "TITLE IV SAFE SCHOOL" or "TITLE IV SAFE SCHOOL CW" allocation category. Schools should schedule their allotment in accordance with their approved program proposal.
