SUBJECT: **English language Learner (ELL) Summer Enrichment Program**

This memorandum provides resources to schools participating in the English Language Learners (ELL) Summer Enrichment Program Grant. Participating schools were required to submit program proposals which were approved by Maria Santos, Executive Director, Office of English Language Learners (ELLs). School allocations are summarized on the attached table.

Restrictions on Funds

Some schools will be provided funding for their ELL Summer Enrichment Program by the Contract for Excellence (C4E). The funds will go to the schools with the highest concentrations of overall need, including ELLs, as per SED regulations.

Title III and C4E requires its funds to support opportunities for language development and academic achievement. [This is supplementary funding, only to be used for supporting services above and beyond the regular summer school programs provided by the NYCDOE.](#) Funded programs will aid ELLs in continuing the academic momentum of the school year by providing quality programs that are stimulating and engaging.

Title III and C4E funds may not be used to purchase core (i.e., basic) textbooks, materials, or supplies for mandated services. All materials and services must be directly aligned with the activities funded by Title III. All Title III expenditures must comply with allowable Title III cost factors and follow the Title III application.

Allocation Formula

The allocation you are receiving was determined using the following considerations: a) The number of ELLs targeted for the program site (host site plus feeder site) must meet a minimum of 100 ELLs; b) One class was funded for each potential enrollment pool of 100 ELLs; and, c) ELLs counted have been in NYC for more than one year and less than six years.

Funds will be allocated directly to the schools that submitted an application (host site and feeder site). [Please note: allocation sites may differ from summer school sites. Please review the allocation table for the location of funds.](#)
