The City Year New York program is a public/private partnership between the New York City Department of Education (DOE), AmeriCorps and private entities. The Department of Education funds will primarily support staff and AmeriCorps members' salaries, which comprise no more than 50% of all costs. Costs would include portions of staff salaries, benefits, AmeriCorps members' stipends, as well as fees for consultants and other non-personnel expenses. Staff and AmeriCorps volunteers are primarily based in schools. The program, first funded by DOE in FY07, will expand to 20 schools in FY10. Tax levy resources are being provided for this venture as presented in the attached table.

City Year organizes 17 to 24-year-olds to volunteer for a year of full-time service to their community and country. In New York City, City Year specifically focuses on high-need public schools. The program's goal is to help children learn to read, stay in school and become engaged in their communities as citizens and future leaders. Through direct mentorship by volunteers as well as through the various programs, children learn about global issues, leadership, conflict resolution and acquire life long social and academic skills. The program nurtures both the volunteers and the children by setting examples and by inspiring them to bring their skills back to their communities. City Year New York has designed and implemented an after school volunteer service program, *AmeriCorps*, as well as a winter break program, and lunch-time programs.

The City Year New York allocation is displayed below. Funds will be automoded into the **"TL One-Time Allocations"** allocation category under object code 685, program name "City Year".
