**SUBJECT:** **Safe Schools Initiative**

The Office of School and Youth Development (OSYD) will support a cadre of high need schools to achieve improved student behavioral outcomes so that each school provides a safe and supportive environment in which students can succeed. The schools receiving this support funding are presented in the table below. They were identified and selected based on the following criteria:

- schools identified as Persistently Dangerous by the New York State Education Department;
- schools designated as Impact schools;
- schools that may be identified as potentially dangerous based on a review of 2008-2009 school incident data;
- schools that are high need based on a review of 2008-2009 school incident data and current 2009-2010 trends

Identified schools will receive services and/or funds for professional development and direct services to students. Professional development is expected to build the capacity of school personnel to sustain long term improved tone and culture beyond the time frame of this initiative. Direct services to students may be provided by internal school staff or external community-based organization partners for social/emotional learning to build their capacity in conflict resolution skills, anger management, positive relationships with peers and adults, and respect for diversity. Program designs will be developed at the respective schools in partnership with OSYD.
